What we offer: The rate of pay for this CUPE bargaining unit position is **\$34.34** per hour. The hours of work for this position will be five (5) days a week, four (4) hour shifts equating to twenty (20) hours per week. We offer a comprehensive benefits package, which includes, extended health and dental coverage, a defined pension plan, life insurance, and short-term disability coverage.

During your first (1st) year of service you will be granted 15 working days of vacation with pay, pro-rated to your permanent hours of work, pro-rated from your start date. Your vacation entitlement will increase with your years of service as per the Collective Agreement.

- High school graduation or equivalent.
- Building Service Worker I and II (BSW I and II) Certification.
- Current Level 1 Occupational First Aid Certificate, including adult CPR certification.
- Must possess and maintain a valid driver's licence, and produce and maintain a clean driver's abstract, as per City policy.
- Minimum six (6) months previous work experience in a janitorial position.
- The successful candidate will be required to pass and maintain RCMP Reliability Security Clearance.
