- Minimum two years' experience teaching music and a thorough understanding of music pedagogy.

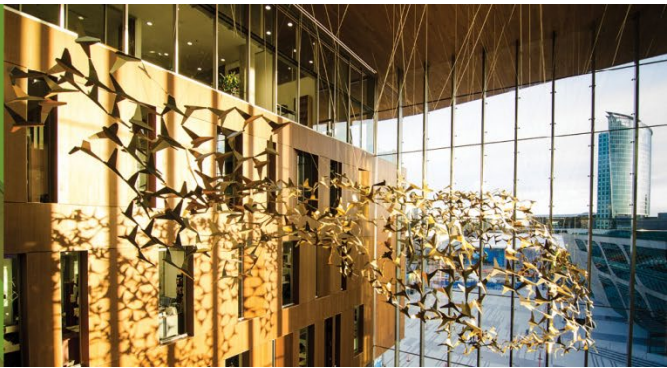
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- Certified RCM Instructor, having completed minimum Level 10 RCM education.
