You also have a basic understanding of the CSA Playground Structure Guidelines and can obtain certification within one year of hire. **A valid Class 5 BC driver's license (or an equivalent from another province) is required. The successful applicant must also be able to obtain and maintain a clear Police Information Check for offenses related to the position. As a condition of employment, the incumbent must complete one course in a subject related to turf from an accredited post-secondary institution within one year of hire. Specifics: Following established safety protocol, the incumbent may be exposed to unpleasant waste materials and other biohazards in the course of their duties. Current shift is Monday to Friday day shift.**
